

Sales Tax Holiday Clothing

Wisconsin's sales tax holiday is Wednesday, August 1, through Sunday, August 5, 2018.

Exempt if the sales price of each item is \$75 or less. **Examples of exempt items include (list is not all-inclusive):**

- Aprons, household & shop
- Athletic supporters
- Baby clothes
- Baby receiving blankets
- Bathing suits & caps
- Beach capes & coats
- Belts & suspenders
- Boots
- Coats & jackets
- Costumes, not including costume masks sold separately
- Diapers, including disposables
- Dresses
- Earmuffs
- Footlets
- Formal wear
- Garters & garter belts
- Girdles
- Glove & mittens for general use
- Hats & caps
- Hosiery
- Insoles for shoes
- Jeans
- Lab coats
- Neckties
- Overshoes
- Pantyhose
- Rainwear
- Pants & rubber pants
- Sandals
- Scarves
- Shirts
- Shoes & shoe laces, not including athletic shoes with cleats or spikes
- Shorts
- Slippers
- Sneakers
- Socks & stockings
- Steel toed shoes
- Sweaters
- Sweatshirts
- T-shirts
- Underwear
- Uniforms, athletic & non-athletic
- Wedding apparel

Clothing does not include sewing equipment, clothing accessories or equipment, protective equipment, and sport or recreational equipment. **Examples of taxable items include (list is not all-inclusive):**

- Athletic shoes with cleats or spikes
- Ballet & tap shoes
- Belt buckles sold separately from clothing
- Breathing Masks
- Briefcases
- Clean room apparel & equipment
- Cosmetics
- Costume masks sold separately
- Ear & hearing protectors
- Face shields
- Gloves, including baseball, bowling, boxing, hockey & golf
- Goggles
- Hair notions, including barrettes, hair bows & hair nets
- Hair pieces
- Hand & elbow guards
- Handbags
- Handkerchiefs
- Hard hats
- Helmets
- Ice Skates
- Jewelry
- Life preservers & vests
- Mouth guards
- Nonprescription sunglasses
- Paint or dust respirators
- Patches & emblems sold separately
- Protective gloves
- Roller skates
- Safety belts
- Safety glasses

- Safety goggles
- Sewing equipment & supplies, including knitting needles, patterns, pins, scissors, sewing machines, sewing needles, tape measures & thimbles

- Sewing materials that become part of clothing, including buttons, fabric, lace, thread, yarn & zippers
- Shin guards
- Shoulder pads
- Ski boots
- Tool belts
