Instructions for Request for Estimate of Withdrawal Tax for Managed Forest Land

General Information

You must file this completed form with the Department of Revenue (DOR) to receive an **estimate** of the tax liability amount due if the identified land is withdrawn from the Managed Forest Land (MFL) designation prior to the original expiration date. You must file a separate form and pay a separate fee for each request. Only one Department of Natural Resources (DNR) Order Number may be entered on a single request.

Landowners may withdraw lands in the following ways:

- · An entire parcel of MFL land
- All MFL land within a quarter-quarter section, government lot, or fractional lot
- An entire MFL entry
- · One to five whole acres for construction or small land sale

Section 1: Land Information

Enter:

- DNR Order Number for the parcel for which the request is being made in the top right corner of the form
- County name, TVC type (T = Town, V = Village, C = City) and municipal name where the land to be withdrawn is located
- Town number, range number, section number, legal description, parcel identification/number and the number of acres the estimate should be based on

Note: Most of this information can be obtained from the property deed, tax bill, and MFL documents. See example entry below.

Section 2: Owner Information

Enter owner's name, daytime telephone number, email address, and mailing address

- Large property check 'Yes' if the owner submitting the request has one or more parcels enrolled in the MFL and/or Forest Crop programs for a total of more than 1,000 acres
- · Conversion check 'Yes' if the parcel was converted from Forest Crop to MFL, and indicate the year of conversion

Section 3: Calculation of Fee for Estimate

Under sec. 77.88(5g), Wis. Stats., a fee must be paid to DOR before DOR will issue a withdrawal tax estimate. The fee equals the **greater** of \$100 **or** \$5 per acre (or partial acre). To calculate the fee, the total number of acres (to the hundredth decimal) auto-fills from Section 1, and is multiplied by \$5. The form automatically displays the correct fee amount to include with your request.

Withdrawal Tax Estimate

The withdrawal tax calculation depends on the type of MFL order.

- Regular MFL orders withdrawal tax equals the past tax liability for the number of years the land was enrolled or ten years, whichever is fewer
- Large property MFL orders withdrawal tax equals the higher of (1) the past tax liability, less any acreage share payments made during the order period, or (2) 5 percent of the average value of the standing timber, less any acreage share payments made during the order period
- Parcels recently converted from Forest Crop to MFL within the last ten years withdrawal tax may be adjusted
