- Form SL-202M – Municipal levy limit worksheet

Due date – December 15, 2024

Failure to file – your county or municipality is **only** eligible for the transfer of service levy limit adjustment on your 2024 levy limit worksheet, under secs. 66.0602(3)(a) and (b), Wis. Stats., unless **both** the transferee and transferor file this notice.
