Free Tax Sites Can Help Prepare and File Taxes

With the tax season deadline two weeks away, Wisconsin Department of Revenue officials encourage people to electronically file their tax return before the April 17 deadline. Free tax assistance sites are located across the state to help low-to-moderate income residents, seniors, veterans, and people with disabilities prepare their tax returns for free.

"The people who help prepare your tax return at the free tax sites are trained volunteers," said Secretary Richard G. Chandler. "Taxpayers can get help with questions or with e-filing their returns at more than 200 sites across the state found in community centers, libraries, churches, shopping malls and retirement homes. Most sites will be open until the end of the tax season."

Please be sure to bring the documents below to the volunteer tax site:

- ✓ Photo IDs for you and your spouse
- ✓ Social security numbers for everyone you will include on your tax return
- ✓ All documents about the income you received during the year (Examples: wage statements, interest and dividend statements, retirement statements, social security statements, mortgage interest statement)
- ✓ Signed rent certificate or property tax bill if you will file for Homestead Credit
- ✓ Your bank account numbers to get refunds deposited into your account (example: bring a deposit slip)
- ✓ Any other tax documents (Examples: property tax receipts for any property taxes paid in 2010, tuition statement, closing agreement for home purchased in 2011)

IMPORTANT: Your spouse must come with you if you are married and filing jointly.
