## Department Returns Excess Football Stadium District Funds to Brown County and Municipalities

Today, the Wisconsin Department of Revenue returned more than \$17 million in excess revenue collected from the professional football stadium district which includes Brown County and its municipalities. State law required the district to have a reserve fund for maintenance and operating costs for the stadium. As of March 30, enough money had been collected and the excess funds are being returned to Brown County and its municipalities based upon population. Each municipality may use the revenue for property tax relief, tax levy supported debt relief, or economic development.
