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Wisconsin Department of Revenue Kicks Off Tax Season

Tax Deadline: April 18, 2016

The Wisconsin Department of Revenue (DOR) is officially kicking off tax season today – the agency is now accepting electronically filed (e-filed) tax returns. This year's individual income **tax deadline is Monday, April 18** because of a federal holiday. Below is a brief look at the upcoming tax season.

E-Filing vs. Paper	With more people doing business online, DOR expects approximately 85% of income tax returns will be filed electronically .
