## Former Waukesha County Resident Charged with Embezzlement and Identity Theft

Stephanie K. Roeglin, a Milwaukee resident, is facing seven felony charges in Waukesha County. Counts one through five is for filing false income tax returns and counts six and seven for filing false claims for credit.

According to the [criminal complaint](#), Roeglin, who was the Executive Director at a Milwaukee County home care facility from 2010 to 2017, created a fictitious employee in order to embezzle \$260,698 from 2013 to 2017. Additionally, Roeglin intentionally overpaid herself \$215,842 for a total embezzlement from her employer of \$476,540.

Roeglin resided in Waukesha County when she filed these income tax returns.

Criminal charges were filed in Waukesha County by the Wisconsin Department of Justice Attorney General's Office on January 10, 2020 after an investigation by Special Agents from the Wisconsin Department of Revenue Office of Criminal Investigation.

If convicted, Roeglin could face 42 years in prison and \$70,000 in fines, or both.
