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## Menominee County sales and use tax starts today

The Wisconsin Department of Revenue reminds people that today, April 1, 2020, the county sales and use tax will be in effect in Menominee County. With the addition of Menominee County, there are now <u>68 Wisconsin counties who have adopted a county tax</u>.

The county tax is a 0.5% tax imposed on the sales price from retail sales, licenses, leases, or rentals of tangible personal property, certain coins and stamps, certain leased property affixed to realty, or certain digital goods, or the selling, licensing, performing, or furnishing of taxable services in a county with a county tax.

Retailers who make sales subject to the 0.5% county tax must collect 5.5% sales tax on their retail sales:

- 5% state sales tax
- 0.5% county sales tax
