Wisconsin Department of Revenue Posts 2025 Preliminary Equalized Values

Madison, WI – Today, the Wisconsin Department of Revenue (DOR) posted its preliminary Equalized Values, Tax Incremental District (TID) Values, Net New Construction Report and County Apportionment Report.

DOR posts the 2025 preliminary Equalized Values Report to provide municipalities with the opportunity to review the values before they are certified on Friday, August 15. It should be noted that preliminary Equalized Values often change before they are certified.

Equalized Values are calculated annually and used to ensure fairness and equity in statewide property tax distribution. The Equalized Value represents an estimate of a taxation district's total taxable value and provides for the fair apportionment of school district and county levies to each municipality. Changes in Equalized Value do not necessarily translate into a change in property taxes.

Local government officials and assessors statewide are encouraged to review their preliminary Equalized Values along with the other posted preliminary reports, and contact DOR's Equalization Bureau as soon as possible before Thursday, August 7, if they have questions or concerns.

Important Dates

- Thursday, August 7 Deadline to review reports and contact an Equalization Bureau District Office about the Preliminary Equalized Values
- Friday, August 15 DOR publishes the 2025 Final Equalized Values, TID Values, Net New Construction Report and County Apportionment Report and notifies stakeholders
