## **CAUTION-NEW FOR 2017**

To qualify for homestead credit, you only need to meet one of the following conditions:

- 1. You, or your spouse if married, are age 62 or older at the end of 2017.
- 2. You, or your spouse if married, are disabled.
- 3. You, or your spouse if married, have earned income during 2017.

If line 1a or 1b on Schedule H or H-EZ is 62 or more, you do not need to complete lines 1c or 1d. If you answer 1c "yes" for either you or your spouse, you do not need to complete line 1d.
