Part A – Calculation of Credit (Entity–level tax) (Postal Abbreviation) State 1 ___ State 2 ___ _ Divide line 1 by line 2. Carry the decimal to four places and fill in on line 3. If line 2 is less than line 1, From the income tax return of the other state, fill in the net tax amount after subtracting all 5 Multiply line 3 by line 4. Round the result to the nearest dollar. If tax was paid on behalf of resident members on a composite return, go on to Part B. Otherwise, skip Part B and go on to Part C. If claiming a credit for net tax paid to Minnesota, Iowa, Illinois, or Michigan, skip lines 11 through 14 Part B – Calculation of Credit (Tax paid on behalf of Wisconsin resident members on a composite return) Divide line 6 by line 7. Carry the decimal to four places and fill in on line 8. If line 7 is less than line 6, From the income tax return of the other state, fill in the net tax amount after subtracting all Multiply line 8 by line 9. Round the result to the nearest dollar. If claiming a credit for net tax paid to Minnesota, Iowa, Illinois, or Michigan, skip lines 11 through 14 and fill in the amount from line Part C - Credit Allowed Divide line 11 by line 12. Carry the decimal to four places and fill in on line 13. If line 12 is less than Fill in the Wisconsin net income tax from Schedule 5S-ET, line 18 or Schedule 3-ET, line 19...... 14 Fill in the smaller of line 15 or line 18. If claiming a credit for net tax paid to Minnesota, Iowa, Illinois, Part D - Total Credit 22 Add lines 20 and 21. This is your credit for tax paid to another state.
