Instructions for Schedule H-EZ

If you qualify for homestead credit (see page 2 of the Schedule H instructions), you may be able to use Schedule H-EZ to file your claim. See "Which Schedule to File" on page 3 to determine if Schedule H-EZ is right for you.

Filling in Schedule H-EZ Round off cents (drop amounts under 50¢ and increase amounts from 50¢ to 99¢ to the next dollar). Do not use commas or dollar signs when filling in amounts.

Amending Schedule H-EZ See "Amending Schedule H or H-EZ" on page 4 of the Schedule H instructions.

STEP 1: CLAIMANT INFORMATION

Does the cover of your Schedule H and H-EZ booklet have a mailing label with your name on it? If yes, place it in the name and address area of the Schedule H-EZ that you file with the department. Is your name or address on the label wrong? If yes, correct the label by drawing a line through the incorrect information and printing the correct information. If your booklet does not have a label, fill in all information requested.

Social Security Number Fill in your (and your spouse's, if married) social security number in the space provided.

STEP 2: QUESTIONS

Fill in the information requested on lines 1 through 3. For more information on legal residency, see the instructions for line 2 of Schedule H.

STEP 3: HOUSEHOLD INCOME

Note: If your spouse died in 2005, see Part 5 on page 12 of the Schedule H instructions before completing the rest of Schedule H-EZ.

Line 4 – Income from Tax Return Fill in the income from your 2005 Wisconsin income tax return. For more information, including instructions for when you have already filed your return, see the instructions for line 7 of Schedule H.

Line 5 – Income - No Tax Return Fill in the amount of your (or the total of both spouses, if married) wages, interest, dividends, and other income taxable to Wisconsin on lines 5a and 5b. Attach a separate schedule if more space is needed. For more information, see the instructions for line 8 of Schedule H.

Lines 6a through 6i – Nontaxable Income Fill in all nontaxable household income received in 2005 from any of the sources indicated. If you are married, combine the incomes of both spouses. Do not include amounts reported on line 4, 5a, or 5b. For more information, see the instructions for lines 9a through 9g, 9i, and 9j of Schedule H. **Note:** Include Medicare premium deductions in any amounts entered on lines 6b or 6c.

Renters – Complete lines 9a and 9b if heat was included in your rent and/or lines 9c and 9d if heat was **not** included. For more information, see the instructions for line 14 of Schedule H.
